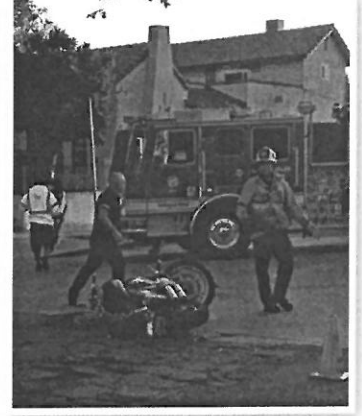

UPDATE: Traffic Safety in our neighborhood

ROAD CHANGES THAT COULD HELP:

TURN RESTRICTIONS

- No left turns from 6th St. onto all North-South streets (Sycamore, Orange, Mansfield, Citrus) during rush hours.
- Right turn only from all North-South streets (Sycamore, Orange, Mansfield, Citrus) onto 6th St. at all times. (i.e., no left turns onto 6th St. and no crossing 6th. St.)

ROAD STRIPING

- Restripe roads at stop signs on 6th St. and Sycamore, Orange, Mansfield and Citrus to include thick white stripe and written out "STOP" on street.

STOP SIGNS

- Stop signs at corners of 4th and Sycamore and 4th and Mansfield.
