The meeting was called to order at 7:42 pm by Board President, Tammy Rosato.

Safety on 6th Street was the focus of the meeting. Tammy began by giving an overview:

- DOT is short staffed city-wide
- DOT studies indicate that speed is not the cause of accidents and that additional signage is not needed on the stretch of 6th between La Brea and Highland
- Accidents are not always reported and as such not counted

It was proposed that one possible solution would be to add speed signs on 6th Street on both sides of the street. The attached map was presented as a jumping off point for discussion. There was agreement that adding the signs might improve safety. The location of the signs was also discussed.

The following motion was made by Cathy Roberts and seconded by Tammy Rosato. The motion passed unanimously.

Motion: The La Brea Hancock Board requests that DOT install two permanent speed monitor signs with one facing West and the other facing East between Highland Ave and La Brea Ave per the attached PDF with DOT confirming the most effective locations based on experience and data. Per DC4 this is funded and will take approximately 90 days from 9-17-19.

Tammy reported that over 60 people attended the Earthquake Preparedness Workshop organized by La Brea Hancock, Sycamore Square, and Miracle Mile. Future efforts will focus on RYLAN.

Tammy noted that the street lights have been out in our neighborhood, Citrus Square, Sycamore Square, Miracle Mile, and Hancock Park. She also mentioned that the October 21 GWNC Transportation Committee meeting will include a discussion of a Bike Line on 4th Street.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 pm.
